 The 19th Regiment Tennessee Infantry was organized for
 State service June 11, 1861; transferred to the service of the
 Confederate States August 15, 1861, and re-organized May 10,
 1862. It was consolidated with the 6th and 10th Tennessee Ten-
 nessee Infantry about January, 1863, and formed a temporary
 1st consolidation.
 About April 9, 1863, the 6th, 8th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and
 15th Tennessee Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed
 the 2d Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry which was
 ordered to Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1863.

*This company was known as Parker's before as Captain Parker's Company, Company C and Company E, 19th Regiment Tennessee Infantry.

The 19th Reg't Tennessee Infantry was organized for State service June 11, 1860; transferred to the service of the Confederate States August 15, 1861, and reorganized May 10, 1862. It was consolidated with the 20th and 41st Regiments Tennessee Infantry about January, 1863, and formed a temporary 30th organization.

About a 20th Reg't the 4th, 5th, 18th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th and 41st Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed the 33rd Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C., May 1, 1863.
