KNOW all men by these presents, That we *David Owen and John Robins of Wilkes County* are held firmly bound unto *Honour Nathl Esq Governor* governor and commander in chief of the said state, in the just and full sum of *five hundred Pounds* current money of the state aforesaid, to be paid to *the said Honour Nathl Esq Governor* his successors and assigns: To which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our and each of us, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Sealed with seal and dated the *fourteenth* day of *December* Anno Dom, 1780

THE condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bound *David Owen* hath made application for a licence for a marriage to be had and solemnized between *him the said David Owen and Missisid Mullens* both of the county of *Wilkes* aforesaid. Now in case it shall not appear hereafter that there is any lawful cause to obstruct the said marriage, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
